2 **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that Plaintiffs Bank Julius Baer & Co. Ltd's  
3 ("BJB") and Julius Baer Bank and Trust Co. Ltd's ("JBBT")  
4 (collectively, "Plaintiffs") state their intention to oppose, in whole or in part, the  
5 third-party motions and applications to appear as prospective intervenors and/or for  
6 leave to file *Amici Curiae* filed with the Court on February 25, 2008 (collectively,  
7 the "Amici-Intervenor Parties"). As of the time of this Notice, the Amici-Intervenor
